Common Name	Description
Bare-root Trees	
Apple 'Anna'	Bred in Israel. Popular variety for warm climates. Sweet, crisp and flavorful. 100-300 Chill Hours
Apple 'Dorsett Golden'	One of few apple varieties suitable for hot climates. Early variety with medium sized fruit and sweet flavor. 100-200 Chill Hours
Asian Pear 'Tennoisui'	Cross between Hosui Asian Pear and Tennessee European Pear. Yellow fruit with slight red blush
Fig 'Improved Brown Turkey'	Large brownish purple fig with pink flesh. Small tree usually produces two crops per year. 100 chill hours
Jujube 'Li'	Also called "Chinese date." Fruit is yellow-green, large and round. Loves the summer heat. Fruit ripens mid August.
Jujube 'Sugar Cane'	Pingpong ball sized fruit. Very sweet with crunchy flesh. Dark red brown color when ripe.
Mulberry, Pakistan Fruiting	Fruit up to 2-3" long. Medium size tree but can reach up to 70 ft. Grows well in moist soils.
Nectarplum 'Spice Zee'	Self-fruitful and very productive. Hybrid cross between a Plum and a Nectarine. One can detect both Plum and Nectarine traits in the fruit. 200-300 chill hours
Nectarine 'Snow Queen'	Clingstone fruit. Early to mid-june. Extremely high-quality. Delicious flavor. Does well in mild winter climates
Nectarine 'Atomic Red'	Fruiting and Flowering nectarine. Exquisite red double flower. Fruit is medium to large and simply delicious.
Peach 'August Pride'	Yellow freestone with rich sweet flavor. Great for canning as well as eating. Self-fruitful with low chilling requirements, about 200 hours
Peach 'Mid-Pride'	Good tree vigor with good quality fruit. Yellow-orange fruit with distinctive red striping. Freestone. 300-400 chill hours
Peach 'Red Baron'	Beautiful pinkish-red, semidouble flowers, and high quality fruit. Self-fruitful. Semi-freestone. 250-300 chill hours
Peach 'Tex King'	Texas A&M introduction. Large, firm yellow flesh clingstone peach. Ripens May to June. 450 chill hours
Peach 'Tex Star'	Semi-freestone variety. Medium sized fruit with yellow, red blushed skin. Great for canning, baking and eating fresh. 450 chill hours
Peach 'Tropic Snow'	One of the best home orchard peaches for mild winter climates. Large white flesh, superb flavor. Freestone. 200 chill hours
Peach miniature 'Bonanza'	High head. Popular yellow freestone, 5-6 ft tree. Large fruit is sweet and low in acid. Low chilling requirements, 150-250 hours. Self-fruitful
Pear 'Kieffer'	Self-fruitful. Large yellow fruit good for canning. Stores well. Chill hours 300-400
Pear 'Southern King'	A high quality pear popular in Houston. Good for fresh eating or canning. Cross between Hosui Asian and Tennessee European. Chill hours 300-350
Persimmon 'Fuyu (Jiro)'	Apple persimmon. Medium size, flat shape, still hard when ripe, non-astringent.
Persimmon 'Fuyu Giant'	Larger, not as flat as Jiro. Crunchy when ripe. Sweet, flavorful, non-astringent.
Plum 'Catalina'	Black plum that stays firm when fully ripe. Better fruit set when planted with a pollinizer like Santa Rosa.
Plum 'Mariposa'	Low chill requirement. Greenish bronze, with burgundy red flesh, small pit, nearly freestone. 200-300 chill hours

Common Name	Description
Plum 'Methley'	Self-fertile. Small, reddish purple fruit. Burgundy flesh color. Excellent quality. 200 chill hours
Plum 'Santa Rosa'	Fairly self-fertile and good polinator for other plum trees. Ripens in June. Purplish red fruit.
Bare-root Grapes and Berries	
Blackberry 'Arapaho'	Thornless. Medium sized, firm, high quality fruit
Blackberry 'Kiowa'	Large fruited, thorny cultivar from The University of Arkansas. Top performer for Texas conditions
Blackberry 'Natchez'	Thornless. Large great tasting berries. Good production and growth with low chilling requirements
Blackberry 'Ouachita'	Thornless. Fruit size similar to Arapaho. Heavy yields and firm berries.
Grape, Muscadine 'Darlene'	Female variety with pinkish/bronze large berries.
Grape, Muscadine 'Fry Seedless'	Female variety. Popular for its large berry size and good flavor. Mid season.
Grape, Muscadine 'Granny Val'	Self fertile. Bronze color berries. Late maturing pollinator.
Grape, Muscadine 'Ison'	Self fertile. Berry color black and very large. Excellent productivity.
Grape, Muscadine 'Late Fry'	Self fertile. Bronze color berries. High sugar content and good vine vigor.
Grape, Table 'Victoria Red'	University of Arkansas/Texas A&M/Tarkington Vineyard. Disease resistant, vigor and high productivity in coastal TX
Potted Fruit Trees and Shrubs	
Avocados:	
Avocado 'Joey'	Cold hardy Mexican variety. Skin is purple-black and egg-shaped fruit has excellent flavor. Heavy producer.
Avocado 'Mexicola Grande'	Has glossy, near black, thin, easy to peel skin. Tree is fast growing and very cold tolerant.
Blueberries:	
Blueberry 'Emerald'	Southern Highbush. Mild sweet flavor, abundant crop. Low chill hours. 150-250 chill hours
Blueberry 'Sweet Crisp'	Southern Highbush. Vigorous grower with medium to large berries. 200 chill hours
Blueberry 'Windsor'	Southern Highbush. Produces a large crop and semi spreading growth habit. 400 chill hours
Blueberry 'Powder Blue'	Rabbiteye. Excellent for hot humid climates. Large berries are light blue with a soft dusting
Blueberry 'Premier'	Rabbiteye. A superb tasting fruit with a little less production. Ripens early to mid season. 550 chill hours
Blueberry 'Southern Bell'	Southern Highbush. High quality berries early in the season. Low chill hours. 400 chill hours
Blueberry 'Gulf Coast'	Southern Highbush. Ripens early, producing medium-sized berries. Great quality. 100-200 chill hours
Chestnut Trees:	
Chestnut 'Dunstan Hybrid'	Resistant to chestnut blight. Dunstan Chestnut have excellent survival rates and nut production. Zones 5-9
Citrus:	
Grapefruit 'Rio Red'	Introduced in Texas. Fruit has excellent red color, with few or no seeds. Loves long hot summers.
Kumquat 'Mewia'	Fruit is large, round, very sweet. Eat skin and all. Tree is a heavy bearer and very ornamental. Grows to 8 ft tall.
Lemon 'Meyer Improved'	Small tree with continuous crops from August - January. Grows to about 10ft tall.

Common Name	Description
Mandarin 'Owari Satsuma'	Very good flavor. Great production. Hardly any seeds. Slow growing but very productive.
Mandarin 'Kishu'	Good for container growing. Fruit is small but very sweet, juicy and seedless. Matures early.
Orange 'Republic of Texas'	Very cold tolerant. A sweet flavorful orange. Documented back to 1847 near Angleton, TX.
Orange 'Cara Cara'	Believed to have developed as a cross between the Washington navel and the Brazilian Bahia navel orange. Very sweet
Figs:	
Fig 'Celeste'	Great fruit tree for our area. Pest and disease resistant. Vigorous tree. Closed Eye. Produces on last year's wood.
Fig 'Improved Brown Turkey'	Large brownish purple fig with pink flesh. Small tree usually produces two crops per year. 100 chill hours
Fig 'LSU Gold'	Large yellow fig with lightred to pink pulp. Open eye. Great for fresh eating and preserving
Fig 'LSU Purple '	Produces large purple fruit with excellent flavor on new growth. Closed eye. High sugar content.
Olives:	
Olive 'Arbequina'	Fast growing olive tree produces delicious fruit and oil. Will grow 15-20 ft tall. Self fertile and a good pollinator.
Pecans:	
Pecan 'Oconee'	Type I. Produces large nuts of outstanding quality and flavor. Adequate disease resistant. Early pollen release.
Pecan 'Pawnee'	Type I. Early maturing variety. Large nut and high kernel percentage. Scab resistant. Early pollen release
Pecan 'Melrose'	Type II. Prolific producer of medium large nuts. Scab resistant. Female flowers pollen released late.
Pecan 'Elliott'	Type II. Considered one of the most disease-resistant varieties. Small, prolific nut of excellent quality. Scab resistant.
Pecan 'Sumner'	Type II. Early bearing, large, good quality. Suited for close space planting. Female flowers pollen released late.
Raspberries:	
Raspberry 'ItSaul Summer'	A raspberry that can grow in South Texas. This rambling raspberry fruits all summer long.
Natives Trees, Onions, Strawberries and Bluebonnets	
Mayhaw	Known for making the world's best jelly. Typically native to swamps but can grow in well drained soils.
Mexican Plum	Beautiful, single trunked, spring flowering small tree. Grows to 25 ft tall.
PawPaw	Host to the zebra swallowtail butterfly. Small tree up to 25 ft. Protect from direct sunlight first 2 years.
Sassafras	Beautiful native tree that grows anywhere from 30-60 ft. Known for its fragrant parts and distinctive leaf shape.
Onion set ' 1015Y	Texas famous onion. Very sweet and called 1015 in honor of the October 15 planting date for the seed. Sets are ready to plant
Onion set 'Southern Belle Red'	Red globe and sweet. Very healthy due to high concentration of quercetins (anti-oxidant compound).
Onion set 'Texas Early White'	Great flavor and easy to grow. Disease resistant. Harvest 105 days from transplants.
Strawberry 'Eversweet'	Produces all summer long in hot weather. Berries are large, cone shaped and very sweet
Bluebonnets	State flower of Texas. Full sun. Likes well drained soils that are alkaline.
